How does it work?

Artisan Assist is designed to work within your Salesforce® environment. Simply install the Artisan Assist App and start making work requests from within your Salesforce® instance.

- 1 Install the Artisan Assist Salesforce® App
- 2 Request assistance using the App
- 3 Clarify Requirements using the Q&A function
- 4 Accept the work estimate
- 5 Test the outcome is as expected
- 6 Approve the work to be deployed
- 7 Accept the work as being complete
- 8 Receive and pay the PS+C Artisan invoice

How do I get Artisan Assist?

Artisan Assist is easily installed from the Salesforce® AppExchange. The App costs AUD\$99 per Salesforce Environment per year. The annual fee is credited against the first work order invoiced in the subscription year making the App free as long as the Artisan Assist service is used.
